## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

***Nominate books for the Nordic History Book Award, which will be awarded at the 30<sup>th</sup> Congress of Nordic Historians in Gothenburg in 2022!***

The purpose of the Nordic History Book Award is to stimulate historical interest in the Nordic region. It will be given to the author/s of the most innovative and thoughtful historical recent work in Nordic history.

The Award winner/s will be announced at the Congress of Nordic Historians, held every third or fourth year, next time in Gothenburg (Sweden) 8–11 August 2022, and the Award consists of a diploma and 7.000 SEK. The winner will be invited to attend the meeting.

The Award has been initiated by the Committee of Nordic Historians, consisting of representatives of the national historical associations, in collaboration with *Scandinavian Journal of History* and the Centre for Nordic Studies at the University of Helsinki (CENS). The first award was given at the 29<sup>th</sup> Congress of Nordic Historians in Aalborg 2017.

### **Who can apply?**

Authors or publishing houses may nominate books about Nordic history. Nordic history is in this respect defined as the history of the Nordic region (in other words: the history of one Nordic country does not apply).

There are no limitations regarding topics or historical periods. Both monographs and edited volumes can be submitted. Books can be in the Nordic languages (including Icelandic and Finnish) or in English, German, or French.

Books should be published in the period since the last Congress of Nordic Historians. This call for nominations covers the period 2017 (May onwards) – 2022 (28 February).
